10w To Install Skoolbag On Your Smartphone

Click the "App Store" icon on your Apple device.

Type your school name in the search, using suburb name will help

You will see your school appear, click "Get" then "install"

The app is FREE to download When installed click "Open"

coggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch. Select "OK" to receive push notifications, when asked. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"

You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using suburb Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device name will help.

Click the school name when it appears in the search.

Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your Click the "Install" button.

Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
